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# Petal Path

61 1/2" x 72" quilt

We designed Petal Path with intermediate quilters in mind. The pieced blocks are called "off-center log cabin blocks" and require a little bit of attention during the cutting phase but the sewing is a snap! The cutting list may seem extensive because the quilt is scrappy.

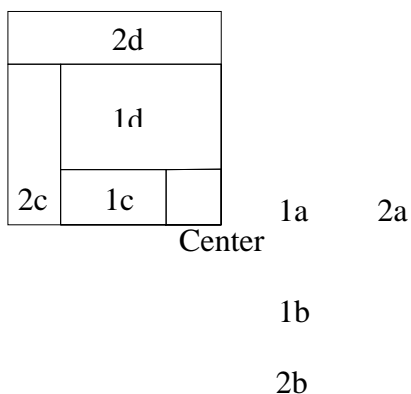

## General information:

- We recommend you cut and piece a single test block prior to cutting the entire quilt. You may sign and date the block and use it as a label on the back of the quilt if you like.
- A word about **borders**: Due to differences in skills and tools, your quilt center may vary from the ideal measurements by a little bit. We always recommend that you **measure your actual quilt center** before cutting borders to exact lengths. Measure horizontally through the **center** of your quilt to get the width and vertically to get the length.
- Seam allowance is 1/4" and is abbreviated as s.a.
- Width of fabric means cross-grain (from selvage to selvage) and is abbreviated wof.
- Finished measurements are not the cut measurements. Finished measurements are the size the block or quilt measures once it has been sewn together.

**Cutting:** You have 2 options when it comes to the borders. If you prefer to have continuous border strips with no seams, purchase the larger amount of border fabrics. We frequently use our leftover fabrics on the back of the quilt. If you don't mind having seams in your borders, purchase the smaller amount of border fabrics and cut and sew them into one long continuous strip. For best use of fabric, cut the largest pieces first.

**A special cutting note about log cabin blocks:** Each off-center log cabin block has a center piece surrounded by two rounds of rectangles. We ask you to cut strips for each round that are the widest width you will need for that round. You cut the widest piece first and the remaining pieces from this strip. The same holds true for the second round. See diagram1. It takes approximately 20" to make the first round and 33" to make the second round. The sewing order is as you would expect...1a, 1b, 1c, 1d. The cutting order is different than expected because strip widths vary. You want to cut the widest pieces first. We list the cutting for these blocks with each type of fabric.



Center: Cut 1- 3" x 3 1/8" rectangle

Round 1: Cut 1 – 2 1/4" x wof strip

Cutting order:

1d: 2 1/4" x 6 1/4"

1 c: 2 1/4" x 4 5/8"

1b: 2" x 4 1/2"

1a: 2" x 3 1/8"

Round 2: Cut 1- 2 1/2" x wof strip

Cutting order:

2b: 2 1/2" x 8 1/4"

2a: 2 1/2" x 6 3/8"

2c: 1 3/4" x 8 3/8"

2d: 1 5/8" x 9 1/2"

Blue Vine:

Cut 4 – 4” x **length of goods** strips for outer borders. Do Not cut to exact lengths until you have measured your quilt center. The ideal lengths are:

Sides: Cut 2 - 4” x 65 1/2”

Top and Bottom: Cut 2 – 4” x 62”

Cut 1 set log cabin second round strips.

Cut 4 flower petals

Blue Dot:

Cut 4 – 2” x **length of goods** strips for middle border. Cut exact lengths from this strip after you have measured your quilt center. The ideals are:

Sides: Cut 2 - 2” x 62 1/2”

Top and bottom: Cut 2 – 2” x 55”

Cut 2 sets log cabin second round strips.

Cut 2 - 3” x 3 1/8” log cabin centers.

Cut 6 flower petals

The remainder is used for binding.

Blue Check:

Cut 1 set log cabin second round strips.

Cut 2 sets log cabin first round strips.

White/blue pindots

Cut 2 – 10 1/2” x w of strips. Remove selvages and sew end to end into one continuous strip. From this cut 1 – 10 1/2” x 55 1/2” strip for flower appliqué background. This is an overcut and is trimmed to 9 1/2” x 54 1/2” after appliqué and pressing.

Cut 6 - 2” x width of fabric strips for inner border. Sew end to end into one continuous strip. From this, cut the inner borders as follows:

Sides: Cut 2 – 2” x 59 1/2” strips

Top and Bottom: Cut 2 – 2” x 52” strips

White Floral:

Cut 3 – 3” x 54 1/2” strips for sashes between rows

Cut 1 set log cabin first round strips.

Cut 3 - 3” x 3 1/8” for log cabin centers

Green Floral Stripe

Cut 5 – 3” x width of fabric strips. Remove selvages and sew end to end into one long continuous strip. From this cut the following ideal measurements:

Sides: Cut 2 – 3” x 54 1/2” strips

Top and Bottom: Cut 2 – 3” x 49” strips

Red Stripe

Cut 2 sets log cabin second round strips.

Cut 1 set log cabin first round strips.

Cut 1 - 3” x 3 1/8” log cabin center.

Red Check

Cut 1 set log cabin second round strips.

Cut 1 - 3” x 3 1/8” log cabin center.

Cut 5 flower petals for appliqué panel

Red Dot

Cut 2 sets log cabin first round strips.

Cut 5 - 3” x 3 1/8” log cabin centers.

Cut 2 flower centers.

**Pink Ovals**

Cut 3 sets log cabin second round strips.

Cut 2 - 3" x 3 1/8" log cabin center.

Cut 1 flower center

**Pink Vine**

Cut 3 sets log cabin first round strips.

Cut 3 - 3" x 3 1/8" log cabin centers.

Cut 5 flower petals

**Yellow Stripe**

Cut 2 sets log cabin second round strips.

Cut 2 sets log cabin first round strips.

Cut 1 - 3" x 3 1/8" log cabin center.

**Yellow Dot**

Cut 3 sets log cabin first round strips.

Cut 1 - 3" x 3 1/8" log cabin center.

Cut 1 leaf for appliqué panel.

**Yellow Ovals**

Cut 1 set log cabin first round strips.

**Yellow Vine**

Cut 2 sets log cabin second round strips

Cut 2 flower centers

**Green Dot**

Cut 2 sets log cabin second round strips.

Cut 1 set log cabin first round strips.

Cut 4 leaves for appliqué panel

**Green Ovals**

Cut 1 set log cabin second round strips.

Cut 1 set log cabin first round strips.

Cut 3 leaves for appliqué panel.

**Green Vine**

Cut 1 set log cabin second round strips.

Cut 1 set log cabin first round strips.

Cut 5 flower petals for appliqué panel.

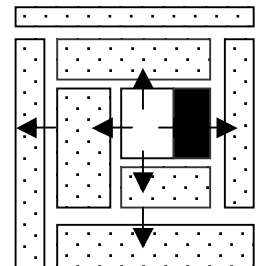
## Make the blocks

**1. Off-center log cabin blocks: Finished Size: 9" square**

Sew first round rectangles 1a, 1b, 1c, and 1 d to a center patch in a counterclockwise manner. Sew second round rectangles 2a, 2b, 2c, 2d to first round as shown in diagrams 1 and 2. All seams are pressed away from center.

## 2. Applique panel:

**Finished size: 9" x 54"**

**Make 1**

- a. Cut 1 10 1/2" x 55 1/2" from **Length** of Goods for appliqué background. If you did not buy a long cut of fabric, cut two 10 1/2" x wof strips and remove selvage ends. Sew into one 10 1/2" strip and cut to 55 1/2" long. This is an overcut. You will want to keep all appliqué patches except the flowers that run off the panel, about 3/4" in from the outside edge.
- b. Position flowers and leaves as shown and appliqué in place. Press. Trim panel to 9 1/2" x 54 1/2".

## **Assemble the Quilt Center:** The quilt center is assembled in columns.

1. Make 3 columns of 6 blocks each. Sew 6 blocks into columns and press to the least number of seams. You might want to rotate some of the blocks just for fun!
2. Sew a green floral 3" x 54 1/2" strip to left side of Column 1 and sew one to right hand side of column 4. Press to green floral.
3. Sew white floral 3" x 54 1/2" strips between columns and press to white.
4. Sew columns together and press to sashes. Quilt measures 49" wide x 54 1/2" tall at this point.
5. Sew green floral stripe 3" x 49" strips to top and bottom of quilt and press to stripe. Quilt measures 49" wide x 59 1/2" tall at this point.

## **Sew the borders:**

1. White Pindot Inner border: If you did not buy a long cut of fabric, sew 6 - 2" strips end to end and cut border strips for this piece. Sew white pindot 2" x 59 1/2" to sides of quilt. Sew white pindot 2" x 52" borders to top and bottom of quilt. Press to pindot.
2. Blue dot Middle border: Sew blue dot 2" x 62 1/2" strips to sides of quilt. Sew blue dot 2" x 55" to top and bottom of quilt. Press to blue dot.
3. Blue Vine Outer border: Sew blue vine 4" x 65 1/2" strips to side of quilt. Sew blue vine 4" x 62" to top and bottom of quilt. Press to blue vine.

Quilt, bind and pat yourself on the back!
